CC Clive Davies advised that he was aware of the ongoing concerns with regard to speed in the village, particularly at the school. He would take up the matter. He would also pursue the matter of footways throughout the village and would follow up on correspondence from a resident concerned with regard to speed at the Croes y Llan crossroads. He noted the concern with regard to vermin observed in Maes y Deri and would ask Tai Ceredigion to address this as a matter of urgency.

Cllr Training

The Council would also expect all Cllrs to attend refresher training on the Code of Conduct following an election. The Council would pay for the training and reasonable and agreed travel expenses.

An Independent Wales – Cllr I Davies

The Council was aware of the feelings of some people living in Wales who wished to explore independence and the 'Yes Cymru' campaign asking for individuals to support a campaign for the right to request an independent Wales. The Council would consider the matter further as and when further information became available.
