**7. County Councillor's Report**

CC Clive Davies advised that although there had been a recent accident at the Croes-y-Llan crossroads it had not been reported to the Police and would therefore not show in statistics. He was still working with CCC on signage to slow traffic from the direction of the Penllwyndu on the B4570. He advised that he was working to keep momentum going on the resilience plan and had noted that last year during the drought at least one water bowser was required where private supplies had failed, something to include in the plan. He advised that CCC would introduce measures to address its impact on the climate emergency. He hoped that the Government would bring forward its deadline in this matter. It was noted that the school had kindly agreed to run a bingo to raise funds for the Eisteddfod 2020. He noted that the 2020 proclamation ceremony in Caradigan and other events on the same day had brought in 13000 new visitors. In addition the town was being visited by tourists from the cruise ships docking at Fishguard. He said that work on a local LoRaWAN network was ongoing and it could potentially assist in rural crime reduction and flood warning among other

possibilities.

*Request from St Dogmaels Community Council*

Pembs County Council had indicated that it may close the public toilets at Poppit. The cost to St Dogmaels to take over the toilet block would be in excess of £16k per annum. Apart from the impact of the costs to the

community, St Dogmaels Community Council believed that PCC had not taken into account the impact of the proposed closure on the surrounding areas and local economy. St Dogmaels Community Council would welcome input from Llangoedmor Community Council re the potential impact on the locality.

It was agreed to write a letter to PCC expressing concern at the proposal as it would impact on health, tourism and the local economy.
