The Council would prefer to provide financial assistance towards specific projects, events or purchases of equipment which provide direct benefit to the Community of Llangoedmor and its' residents. However, it will also support ongoing revenue costs if an organisation can demonstrate its lack of funds and the adverse effect on Llangoedmor and its residents if the organisation is unable to continue or is hampered by lack of funds.

Applications will only be accepted from charitable and non-profit making organisations. The council regrets that applications from commercial organisations or individuals will not be considered.

Welsh Air Ambulance Charitable Trust (Wales Air Ambulance)

2. Please describe below (please attached additional sheets if required) the project/ event you are applying for funding for or the reasons why your organisations requires funds

At Wales Air Ambulance, our mission is to deliver lifesaving advanced medical care to people across Wales whenever and wherever they need it, which includes the Llangoedmor community. Wales Air Ambulance offers advanced critical care and is often described as a 'Flying ED'. The on-board consultants and critical care practitioners are highly skilled and carry some of the most pioneering medical equipment in the world. They can deliver blood transfusions, administer anaesthesia and undertake emergency operations at the scene of the incident, before flying the patient directly to specialist care.

Like all charities, we are feeling the impact of the global increase in the cost of goods and services. As a result, the amount required to deliver our lifesaving service has risen significantly, and we need your help. We need to raise £11.2 million to keep our 4 helicopters in the air and 8 rapid response vehicles on the road.

We are on standby 24/7, 365 days a year and in 2022 we attended 3368 missions, with 70 in your region of Ceredigion. With your support, we are able to help those who are critically ill or injured. This includes people like David, who whilst getting ready for bed suffered a cardiac arrest and was left fighting for his life. Wales Air Ambulance was dispatched and provided emergency department-standard treatments in his home. Our onboard medics gave David a general anaesthetic and placed him on a ventilator to breathe for him. This course of treatment not only saved David's life but also protected his brain from long-term injury. Speaking about David's treatment, Jo Yeoman, Wales Air Ambulance Patient Liaison Nurse, said: "The procedure is delicate, complex and time-critical. It is only possible outside of a hospital environment through the Wales Air Ambulance and the fact that we have experienced consultants on board. David had the best possible care before reaching the specialists at hospital." Following his recovery, David said: "I am forever grateful to the Wales Air Ambulance Charity and I really appreciate everything they've done for me. If it wasn't for them, I wouldn't be here."

Any amount of donation would be gratefully received, to help us continue to provide lifesaving advanced medical care in your area.

We send an appeal to all community councils in Wales. We also fundraise through individual donations, community fundraising and events, legacies, corporate giving, grants and trusts, charity shops and through our in-house Lifesaving Lottery.

Although the Wales Air Ambulance Charity 2021/22 accounts reflect healthy reserves, we are now facing significant increases in service costs. Our aviation costs alone will increase by 40% from January 2024 onwards as we begin a new aviation contract. Due to these increases in costs, unfortunately we have forecast deficits for the next 4 years, therefore your support would make a real and lasting difference to our charity.

In the event you do not use funding, as detailed in this application, provided by Llangoedmor Community Council it should be refunded to the Council.
