Introduction

Llechryd Football Club has asked the Council to consider their grant application for £2,000 to help purchase goal posts.

Summary of the Grant Application and Additional Information

The football club wants to purchase an additional set of full-size goal posts so that it can expand its activities and accommodate more fixtures at the venue. The additional goals will enable the club to launch a third team and expand training capacity.

The total cost of the project is \pounds 4,899.99 and the football club is seeking a grant of \pounds 2,000.00. The club will provide the Council with receipts to validate the use of the grant.

The club has strong links with the community and local schools and seeks to promote health, wellbeing, and teamwork through football.

The grant application is attached as Appendix 1 to this report.

Action

Motion: That the Council awards a grant of up to £2,000 to Llechryd Football Club towards the cost of new goal posts.

As a result, we are aiming to establish a third team, which will not only ease pressure on our current squads but also provide more opportunities for local players to get involved and progress within the club. Having access to an additional set of full-size goals is essential to this expansion, as it will allow us to train effectively and accommodate more fixtures.

Our long-term vision is to continue being at the heart of the community, promoting health, wellbeing, and teamwork through football. We would also continue to seek additional funding through local fundraising events, sponsorships, and possible contributions from club members or supporters.

While the full set of goals is essential for launching a third team and expanding training capacity, we would not abandon the project if full funding isn't available. Instead, we would adapt our timeline and scale of implementation while maintaining our focus on youth development and community engagement.

Ultimately, we are determined to achieve our goal and will continue to work proactively to ensure the club grows and thrives, with or without the funding.
