Introduction

The National Eisteddfod has asked the Council to consider their grant application for a contribution to the National Eisteddfod to be held in Llantood in 2026.

The grant application was dealt with under item 6.6.1, paper reference November 2025-3, on the November 2025 agenda but did not specify an amount for the grant. It was agreed that a grant would be awarded in principle with the amount to be agreed in the future.

As a result of this Cllr J. Culley suggested that the Council look at grants by Councils of a similar size. This approach has been modified in this paper to look at Community Council contribution per head of population.

Contributions to the National Eisteddfod by Community and Town Councils

A table setting out the contribution of councils by head of population is set out in Appendix 1 to this paper.

The results are summarised in Table 1.

Minimum	0.568

Subsequent to this Cllr D. Ladd has proposed that the National Eisteddfod be awarded a grant of £2,000 and this is to be voted on by the Council. This would amount to a contribution £1.762 per head of population.

Motion: That the Council awards a grant of £2,000 to the National Eisteddfod.
