Introduction

The Council is contributing to the Active Travel Network Map Consultation.

Response

The Council's proposed response to the Active Travel Network Map Consultation as formulated by Cllr C. Wychwood is attached as Appendix 1 to this paper.

The original e mail was circulated to the Council for comment but no responses have been received.

Action

Motion: That the Council adopts the response to the survey set out in Appendix 1 and instructs the Clerk to complete the online survey.

Appendix 1

A2: The whole route

Q3: How could it be improved, for example: footpath widening, lighting, drop kerbs, drainage?

A3 (suggested wording):

This route represents a vital Active Travel corridor linking Llechryd and the surrounding Llangoedmor community to Cardigan, the nearest town and centre for employment, education, health care and services.

Despite being identified on the Active Travel Network Map for several years, it remains no more than a line on a map, with no meaningful on-the-ground provision for people who wish to walk, cycle, or travel safely without a car.

Improvements should include continuous and safe footway and cycle provision along the route, appropriate separation from traffic where necessary, safe crossing points, dropped kerbs, improved drainage, and lighting where appropriate. The aim should be to create a route that is genuinely usable by families, older residents, people with mobility challenges, and less confident cyclists.

The delivery of this route would directly support the objectives of the Active Travel (Wales) Act, contribute to sustainable transport outcomes identified in the Mid Wales Sustainable Transport Plan, and provide a realistic alternative to car dependency for this community.

Residents of Llangoedmor and Llechryd are in clear need of a safe, accessible and continuous means of walking and cycling to Cardigan. Llangoedmor Community Council strongly supports this route being prioritised for progression beyond the planning stage and into delivery.
